PUBLIC COMMENTS:

OLD BUSINESS:

There was no old business.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Selena Griffitt gave an update presentation for the Engineering Department.
 - Prima Vista Boulevard has been completed.
 - Edwards Road Reconstruction estimated construction to begin 3/12/21 by Ranger Construction.
 - Gordy Road Bridge Replacement was BOCC bid awarded to Vecellio & Grogan, Inc. on 12/1/20.
 - Old Dixie Hwy Bridge Replacement Notice to Proceed will be issued in January 2021 and is waiting for a proposal.
 - Keen Road Bridge Replacement Notice to Proceed was issued to Inwood for the design in October 2020.
- Chris Lestrage gave an overview on Repaving Projects .
 - Orange Ave. Guardrails (7 ½ miles) and Gordy Road are in process.
 - Easy Street and Midway Road projects are scheduled to be done in January/February 2021.
 - Delaware Ave. budget was diverted to the above mentioned projects. Negotiations with the City have caused delays in this project moving forward.
- Patrick Dayan gave updates on Water Quality projects.
 - Melville Road stormwater plan – bids received and state grant assisted.
 - Harmony Heights - 90% of drainage complete.
 - Lakewood Park improvements – received 30” of rain in 3 days and upsizing of culverts will be needed in the Ft. Pierce Farms district.
 - Savannas Task Force has been initiated to develop a plan to control flooding to surrounding neighborhoods.
- Mark Satterlee discussed the presentation of the DRAFT Committee Annual Report to Board of County Commissioners.
 - Annual report will presented at the day meeting. A meeting will be set up to review the report approximately one week before the Board meeting.
 - Discussion of the use of Media and Social Media outlets to let citizens know what’s happening in the County for the tax money.

- Mike Monohan suggested that photos should be of projects that are currently being worked on instead of random.
