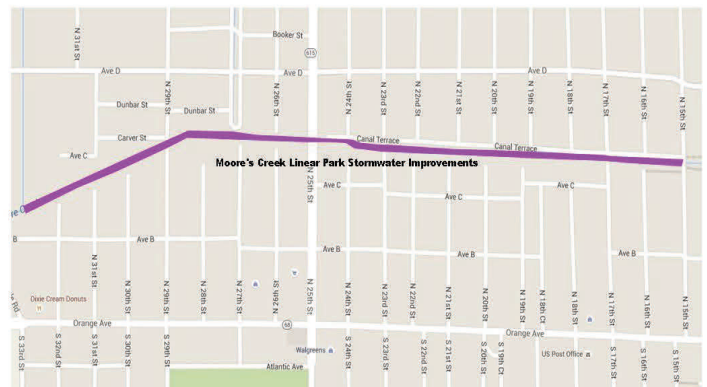

## Project Summary

The continuation of the linear park concept from North 15th Street west to North 33rd Street Canal. The project would include canal enlargement, reshaping, pedestrian walkways, lighting and landscaping.
